**Emergency medicine training: A prospective, comparative study of an undergraduate clinical clerkship and an army programme.**

**Overview:** To evaluate and compare the educational impact of the University of Geneva Faculty of Medicine (UGFM) emergency medicine clerkship training with that provided by the Swiss Army medical officer cadets school (ARMY). The assessment was designed to assess students' clinical knowledge and competency in major emergency situations, ACLS (Advanced Cardiac Life Support) and ATLS (Advanced Traumatic Life Support).

**Conclusions:** With the exception of the ARMY MCO performance, both training programs seemed to be effective in improving trainees' overall knowledge and clinical performance.
