### High school students as ambassadors of CPR-A model for reaching the most appropriate target population?

**Overview:** There is mismatch in age between those usually trained in CPR and those witnessing out-of-hospital cardiac arrest. This study used high school students as first tier CPR "trainers" and encouraged them to train older people.

**Conclusions:** People trained at home with a manikin-DVD set and high school students as facilitators were able to perform CPR as recommended by ERC guidelines with a reasonable percentage aged 50 or older.
