Overview: The presence of physicians is believed to facilitate optimal management of out-of-hospital cardiac arrest, but has not been sufficiently documented.

Conclusions: Survival after out-of-hospital cardiac arrest was not different for patients treated by the PMA and non-PMA in our EMS system.
